N O T I C E

Pursuant to the order of the Hon'ble the Chief Justice dated 23.04.2025, two minutes' silence will be observed at 12.00 noon on 24.04.2025 to pay tribute to, and in the memory of, those who lost their lives on account of the act of terrorism in Pahalgam in the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir.

The following procedure will be adopted in this connection:

1. To indicate the commencement of two minutes' silence, a bell will be sounded at 11.59 a.m. till 12.00 noon.
2. At the appointed time, i.e. 12.00 noon, the Hon'ble Judges, Lawyers, members of the staff and all other persons present in the Hon'ble Court will stand up and will observe two minutes' silence.
3. After the two minutes' silence is over, a signal bell will again be sounded at 12.02 p.m. to mark the end of the observation of silence.

The same procedure will be adopted at the Circuit Benches of Calcutta High Court at Port Blair and Jalpaiguri, Judicial Academy, Judges' Guest House at Bijan Bhawan and all the District including Sub-Divisional Courts in West Bengal.
