**Sub:** Relaxation of norms regarding the requirement for Prior Permission to purchase cars from "regular or reputed dealers" by the Judicial Officers in connection with the Judgment dated 04.01.2024 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in WP(C) no. 643 of 2015 regarding implementation of the recommendations of the SNJPC.

**Sir/Madam,**

With reference to the aforementioned earlier Memo of this Hon'ble Court relating to the subject captioned above, I am directed to inform all concerned that the Hon'ble Court has been pleased to relax, **until further order**, the norms regarding the requirement for Prior Permission to purchase car by the Judicial Officers in connection with the Judgment dated 04.01.2024 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in WP(C) no. 643 of 2015.

Monitory ceiling towards purchase of car (Standard Petrol/ Diesel/ Green/Hybrid Models) from "regular or reputed dealers", however, shall remain unchanged at Rs. 20,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Lakhs only).

I am, therefore, would like to request you to cause circulation of the above direction amongst all the WBSJ officers posted in your Judgeship/under your control/posted on deputation in the various departments of Government of West Bengal, requesting them to act accordingly.
