

IN THE HIGH COURT AT CALCUTTA

It has been noticed that there has recently been a remarkable increase in the footfall in the High Court, sometimes for no purpose at all. The number of persons in the courtrooms has increased alarmingly and the Covid protocol seems to be followed in the breach in the corridors with unnecessary crowding. Work-stations also appear to have been set up in the corridors.

In order to tackle the recent spurt in Covid cases in the High Court, all concerned are requested to enter the court precincts only when absolutely necessary. If Covid protocols are not maintained, judicial work may be suspended without any notice. No work-station should be set up in the corridors.

No matter at the motion stage may be moved in physical form in any court. Only learned Advocates representing the Union or the State may be physically present. This will take immediate effect.

Learned Advocates are requested to cooperate with the administration to ensure the continued functioning of the High Court at the present level.
