**FOR ADMINISTRATIVE CONVENIENCES THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES ARE
ISSUED:**

- Auditorium of the Calcutta High Court at the 9th floor of the Sesquicentenary Building will be used by the High Court administration and the three wings of the Bar, for the following purposes:
 - Organising seminar, colloquium, interactive sessions etc. for spreading and propagation of legal education and knowledge and other academic purposes;
 - Organising seminar, colloquium, interactive sessions etc. for and in connection with judicial and administrative function of Indian and West Bengal Judiciary;
 - Any other related purpose as may be approved by the Hon'ble Chief Justice/Acting Chief Justice.
- Permission to use the auditorium on application of the Bar Associations may be considered if such use is related to the purposes mentioned above.
- Use of the auditorium for any political purpose by any political party or its followers or for propagation of any political message or for any religious or any other sectarian purpose is strictly prohibited.
